

**REGULATIONS OF THE
WORLD CUP «MEMORIAL OF A. KHARLAMPIEV» 2016
MEN, WOMEN AND COMBAT SAMBO**

Moscow

1. Purpose of the competition

- Popularization of sambo worldwide;
- Upgrading mastery of sambo for sportsmen;
- Competition for the Sambo World Cup;
- Strengthening of sambo communication in sport.

2. Dates and Terms

The World Cup «Memorial of A. Kharlampiev» 2016 among sports sambo for men and women, combat sambo for men hereinafter (Competitions or Event) will be held in Moscow within March 24-27, 2016, the day of arrival is on March 24, and the day of departure is on March 27.

3. Management on organization and holding of the competitions

General management of the organization and holding of the competitions is carried out by the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS) (hereinafter FIAS), Ministry of sports of the Russian Federation (hereinafter Minsport of Russia), «All-Russian sports and sports public organization Russian Sambo Federation» (hereinafter Federation), Department of physical culture and sport of Moscow (hereinafter Moskomspor) and Regional public organization "Sambo Federation of Moscow" (hereinafter Sambo Federation of Moscow).

The powers of the Minsport of Russia as organizer of the international competitions are carried out by the Federal state autonomous institution "Management on organization and holding of sports events".

Direct holding of the competitions is assigned to the Federation and the Referees panel approved by the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS).

4. Participation terms

The Competitions will be held according to the regulations for organizing and holding official FIAS competitions (sport and organizational rules) (hereinafter regulations).

The Competitions will be held in the following weight categories:

- sports sambo (men) – 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, + 100 kg;
- sports sambo (women) – 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, + 80 kg;
- combat sambo (men) – 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, + 100 kg.

National sambo federations affiliated to FIAS have the right to take part in the Competitions (athletes not younger than 1998).

Composition of the delegation: 32 persons, including 27 athletes, 3 coaches, 1 doctor, 1 head of the delegation.

One athlete per weight category from national team is allowed to take part in the competition.

Only the athletes possessing a license book with the mark confirming payment of FIAS annual license for 2016 are admitted for participation in the competitions. The athletes, coming to compete in the tournament, but failed to pay the license on time, must pay an annual license (USD 25) on the spot. The athletes,

who do not have a license book, have a possibility to buy it for USD 10 from the FIAS treasurer or an authorized person by him.

5. Accreditation

The heads of national teams participating in the Competition should submit documents confirming their payment of the FIAS annual membership fee by the federations (the payment order with a bank mark of money transfer) during the accreditation to the FIAS Treasurer or an authorized representative.

6. Insurance of the participants

The participation in the competition is only possible if the participants present documents confirming medical live and health insurance.

Original insurance should be submitted to the Organizing Committee.

Insurance of participants of the Competitions should be paid by national sambo federations whose teams take part in the competitions.

7. Doping control

The doping tests are carried out by the official regional anti-doping agency recognized by WADA. The selection of athletes for tests will be run according to the FIAS Anti-Doping provisions 2015 based on WADA Anti-Doping Code 2015.

After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected athletes will be always accompanied by the official representative of the organization. The appointed person (his/her corresponding representative in accordance with FIAS Anti-Doping regulations 2015) may accompany the athlete. If the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it, the selected athlete will be required to provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control.

8. Results of the competitions

The order of bouts, the winners and prize-winners of the competitions should be performed in accordance with international sambo competitions rules (sports and combat). Competitions are individual.

9. Awarding

The winners and prize-winners of the competitions are awarded medals, diplomas and cups of FIAS. Other organizations may provide additional awards and prizes.

10. Financial terms

FIAS, Federation, Moscow Sambo Federation, Minsport of Russia, Moskomsport provide equity participation financing of the Competitions as agreed by the parties.

The expenses related to the participation in the Competition should be covered by sending organization.

The heads of delegations must fulfil all financial obligations with Organizing Committee on the day of arrival and satisfy the accreditation requirements.

FIAS pays for the travel of the Chief Referee and Chief Secretary of the Competitions and pays for their work at the rate of \$ USD 100 per day of the competitions including the days of arrival and departure, as well as covers the payment for 25 referees at the rate of \$ USD 50 per day of the competition, except days of arrival and departure.

11. Media

The Organizing Committee of the Event provides all the necessary conditions for work of media representatives at the Event in compliance with FIAS media guidance.

To be accredited a media representative must preliminary complete the appropriate accreditation form in the section *Media centre - Accreditation* on FIAS official website www.sambo-fias.org by specifying in the *Comments* section the name of the competition *World Cup «Memorial of A. Kharlampiev» 2016*. This form must be completed no later than March 20, 2016.

12. Television

All broadcasting rights of the Event belong to FIAS. The Organizing Committee provides the broadcast of the Event in accordance with FIAS television guidance.

13. Marketing and advertising

The Organizing Committee of the Event guarantees the rights of sponsorship to the FIAS sponsors and partners in compliance with FIAS marketing guidance.

14. Security

The Competitions are held in the sports venue included in the All-Russian register of sports venues in accordance with the Federal law from December 4, 2007 № 329-FZ "Physical culture and sport in the Russian Federation" meeting the requirements of the relevant normative legal acts acting on the territory of the Russian Federation and aimed at ensuring public order and security of participants and spectators, as well as meeting the requirements of the regulations.

15. Application for participation

The Application forms for participation in the Competitions should be submitted by the national sambo federations no later than March 1, 2016 in accordance with the regulations.
