

Indoor air-conditioned sports hall of the Ministry of Sports with a capacity of 5'000 spectators (SND Sports Hall).









4. Payments

- 2. Upon receipt of the payment will be sent a confirmation letter with details of the reservation made.
- 3. 100% of accommodation fee must be deposited into the bank account below relating, no later than August 10.
- 4. Partial or full payments made before August 1, 2016 can be applied to a full refund at the request of the Federation depositor performed within a period not more than 5 days from that date, the charges incurred for the return shall be borne by the applicant.
- 5. Payments made after 00:01 of August 1, 2016 shall not be subject to refund in any case.
- 6. Check-in time at the hotel is 14:00, check-out is at 12:00.
- 7. Extra services (mini-bar, telephone calls, laundry, taxi etc.) will be charged to the room account and must be paid before leaving the hotel by the corresponding delegation.

The Organizing Committee will not impose economic penalties to countries that are not able to make the bank transfer, but these countries must guarantee that they will make the payment by cash on arrival. However, these countries should inform exactly the number of participants and their names within the final deadlines. Reservations of extra rooms can be done with a surcharge of 10%, without any exceptions.

5. Transportation

The Organizing Committee guarantees that all transportation of referees, athletes, coaches and officials during competitions, as well as airport transportation (bus station) to the hotel and vice versa, will be free of charge.

6. Insurance

Each National Federation is responsible for its competitors and should assume all the responsibility for the accident and health insurance, as well as civil responsibilities for competitors and officials, during the Pan American Championships.

The organizer of the Pan American Championships will not be responsible for any claims in cases of injury, disease or death arising out of participation or travel related to the Championships.

7. Deadlines for application

Preliminary entry (by number): 20 July, 2016
Hotel reservation (50% value): 31 July, 2016
Visa application (copy of passport): 20 July, 2016
Hotel payment: 10 August, 2016
Final entry (by name): 10 August, 2016
Travel Information: 16 August, 2016

Delegations that miss the final registration date will not be allowed to participate.

All competitors, coaches and officials must register in time. Nobody will be added after the deadline.

NOTE: Only in case of proven injury, the replacement of a member of the already registered delegation will be allowed.

8. Official Registration and Accreditation

The official registration and issuing of accreditation cards will be held at the Hotel Presidente on August 25 between 10:00 and 19:00.

At least one team's official should attend in time to confirm the official entry of all athletes and other officials with his signature. The non-submission of data from the delegation for official registration may give rise to exclusion of all participants from the draw and the event. In case of unexpected delay in the arrival of the delegation, the National SAMBO Federation should communicate immediately with any of the contact persons of the Organizing Committee. The accreditation card will be issued with photograph for competitors, officials and media. This accreditation card must be carried at all times.

Passports or copies of passports of all competitors must be available in case they will be required.

The following documents should be submitted to the Organizing Committee to obtain the accreditation card: entry list of the delegation, signed and sealed by the responsible person of the National SAMBO Federation; passport; license book (for referees and competitors); health insurance (for competitors). Participants will not be accredited if they do not meet the above mentioned requirements and no exceptions will be made.

IMPORTANT: To be able to participate in the championships, all athletes MUST have FIAS license book with a corresponding mark confirming payment of the FIAS annual license for present year. In case an athlete doesn't have a license book or license, he must pay 25 US dollars for license and 10 US dollars for license book on-site during the accreditation.

9. Number of Participants

Each delegation can register a maximum of 27 athletes, one for each weight category, gender and discipline (Sport SAMBO or Combat SAMBO, in case of men) and a maximum of 7 officials (Representatives: 1, Coaches: 3, Referees: 2, Doctors: 1).

10. Competition rules

- a) The competitions will be held under the latest rules and regulations approved by the FIAS, FIAS Refereeing rules and FIAS Anti-Doping rules.
- b) Weight categories:

Sport SAMBO

- Men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100
- Women: 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, +80

Combat SAMBO:

- •Men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100
- c) Duration of a bout: MEN (Sport and Combat SAMBO) 5 minutes, WOMEN 4 minutes.

- d) Men will be able to compete in both disciplines: Sport SAMBO and Combat SAMBO.
- e) Competition system with group distribution, elimination and repechage from semi-finalists will be applied in the championships.

11. Referees

Referees will be appointed by the FIAS Referees Commission.

12. Weigh-in

The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Rules.

The weigh-in will be held in the Hotel Presidente and SND Sports Hall.

13. Uniform and Equipment Control

Uniform control: Competitors must wear a uniform approved by FIAS according to the FIAS Rules and FIAS Competition Regulations.

Equipment control: It will be done by the referees before each bout.

If an athlete does not respect uniform policy, the coach found responsible will be suspended for the rest of the competition day. In case of recurrence, the coach will be suspended for the rest of the competition.

13.1 Particular rules for female athletes

The competitors must wear a t-shirt under the sambo jacket (t-shirt should be white or almost white, with short sleeves, long enough to be used within the shorts) or a smooth colour suit (white or almost white with short sleeves). No brand can be visible when the sambo jacket is fastened. All other regulations must be respected.

14. Anti-Doping Control

Doping controls will be conducted by the Anti-Doping Organization officially recognized by WADA. The selection of the athletes will be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2015 which are based on 2015 WADA Code and available at www.sambo-fias.org. The selected athletes will be accompanied by a chaperone since the moment when they receive the notice until they arrive to the doping control station. One person according the choice of the athlete (the team physician, trainer and head of delegation) can accompany him/her and observe the doping controls procedure. In the case of which the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation card with photography the selected athlete is required to provide to the Doping Control Officer a valid passport or identity document with photography. Please consider the possible delay caused by doping control and do not book your return flight ticket immediately after the competition finishes.

15. VISA

The Organizing Committee will be pleased to help any country with obtaining visas for athletes and officials. Countries that require visa to enter Paraguay, please send to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible (deadline – July 20, 2016) the list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth and functions within the delegation.

16. Code of Conduct

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in the Pan American Championships have to respect and accept the authority of the FIAS, FIAS officials, FIAS Statutes, FIAS Competition Regulations, FIAS Refereeing Rules, FIAS Anti-Doping Rules, FIAS Disciplinary Code, FIAS Bylaws, FIAS Code of Ethics, FIAS Disciplinary Code, FIAS Referees Code of Conduct.

17. Awarding ceremony

Competitors wearing their red set of sambo uniform will remain stand behind the podium according to the following order 2 - 1 - 3 - 3. Each competitor having won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive his medal and diploma in person. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony without a valid reason, he will lose the right to receive the medal. It is strictly forbidden for competitors on the podium to bring national flags or any other similar identification different of represented on their uniform. Any demonstration of religious, political, personal or commercial signs is prohibited, as well as it's prohibited to wear a cap or any other head cover.
