**Regulations of the
Caribbean International Invitational Open SAMBO Championships
(Sports and Combat SAMBO for men and women)**

Trinidad and Tobago

1. Purpose of the Competition

- 1.1. Popularization of SAMBO in the Caribbean;
- 1.2. Improving of athletes' mastery of SAMBO;
- 1.3. Strengthening of SAMBO communication in sport.

2. Dates and Venue

The Caribbean International Invitational SAMBO Championship (CIIOSC) 2018 among Sports and Combat SAMBO for men and women, (hereinafter Competition or Event) will be **held in Couva, Trinidad on April 28th 2018, the day of arrival is April 27th and the day of departure is April 29th, 2018**

3. Management and Organization of the Competition

General management of the organization and holdings of the Competition is carried out by the Trinidad & Tobago SAMBO and Combat SAMBO Federation following the most recent competition and technical regulations of the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS).

4. Participants of the Competition and Participation Terms

The Competition will be held according to the Regulations for organizing and holding official FIAS Competitions (sports and organizational rules) (hereinafter Regulations).

The Competition will be held in the following weight categories:

- Sport SAMBO (men) – 52,62,74,90+
- Sport SAMBO (women) 56,60,60+
- Combat SAMBO (women)-56,60,60+
- Combat SAMBO (men) – 52,62,74,90+

5. Accreditation

The heads of national teams participating in the Competition should submit documents confirming the payment of the FIAS annual membership fee by the federations (the payment order with a bank mark of money transfer) during the accreditation to the FIAS Treasurer or an authorized representative.

6. Insurance of the Participants

The participation in the Competition is only possible if each participant submits documents confirming his/her life and health insurance.

Original insurance is submitted to the Organizing Committee.

Insurance of Competition participants is paid by National SAMBO Federations whose teams take part in the Event.

7. Doping Control

The doping controls are carried out by the recognized WADA official regional Anti-Doping Organization. The selection of athletes for doping controls will be run according to the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules based on 2015 WADA Code.

After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected athletes will be always accompanied by the official representative of the Anti-Doping Organization. The appointed person (his/her corresponding representative in accordance with FIAS Anti-Doping Rules may accompany the athlete. If the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it, the selected athlete will be required to provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control. All athletes are required to plan in advance the date and the time of their departure after the end of the competitions taking into consideration that any athlete may be chosen for doping control.

8. Competition Results

The order of bouts, the winners and prize-winners of the competitions should be performed in accordance with FIAS International SAMBO Competitions Rules (Sports and Combat).

9. Awarding

The winners and prize-winners of the competitions will be awarded the medals, diplomas and cups.

Other organizations may provide additional awards and prizes.

10. Financial Terms

The expenses related to the participation in the Competition should be covered by sending organization.

The heads of delegations must fulfill all financial obligations with Organizing Committee on the day of arrival and satisfy the accreditation requirements and pay 100 USD per day per each person for accommodation and board and 20 USD per each person for transfer airport-hotel-sports hall-airport.

Chief Referee

FIAS pays for the travel of the Chief Referee and Chief Secretary of the Competitions and pays for their work at the rate of 100 USD per day of the competitions including the days of arrival and departure, it also covers the payment for referees at the rate of 50 USD per day of the competition, except days of arrival and departure.

The Organizing Committee of the Event is responsible for providing accommodation, local transport and volunteer translator for the Chief Referee and Chief Secretary of the Competitions.

11. Media

The Organizing Committee of the Event provides all the necessary conditions for work of media representatives at the Event in compliance with FIAS media guidance.

To be accredited a media representative must give their names no later than **March 30th 2018** in order to complete the appropriate accreditation for the **Caribbean International Invitational Open SAMBO Championships**.

Television

Broadcasting of the Event: the Organizing Committee provides the live broadcast of the Caribbean International Invitational Open SAMBO Championships Finals to 45 countries.

12. Security

The Competitions are held in the National Cycling Velodrome and venues in accordance with the law "Physical culture and sport in the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago " meeting the requirements of the relevant normative legal acts, acting on the territory of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and aimed at ensuring public order and security of participants and spectators, as well as meeting the requirements of the regulations. Security would be provided by the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service.

13. Application for Participation

The Application forms for participation in the Competitions should be submitted by the national SAMBO Federations no later than April 10th 2018 in accordance with the regulations.

14. Visa Support

If the delegates need visa support for arrival to Trinidad and Tobago, please fill out Annex 2 and submit it to OC with copies of passports and data on the consular departments where the visas shall be received before April 10th, 2018. If visa support application is submitted after April 10, 2018 OC does not guarantee possibility of visa support.
