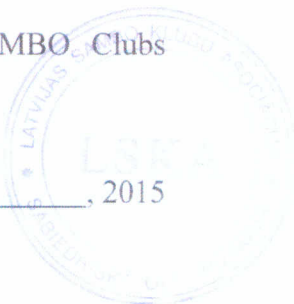

## REGULATIONS World SAMBO Championship AMONG YOUTH (M&W) AND JUNIORS (M&W)

### 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1. World SAMBO Championship among youth (M&W) and juniors (M&W) 2015 (hereinafter referred to as the World SAMBO Championship) shall be held in accordance with the FIAS Regulations on Preparation and Staging of the Official Competitions (sports and organizational rules) and the International SAMBO Competitions Rules.
- 1.2. World SAMBO Championship shall be held for promotion and development of SAMBO worldwide, and strengthening of the international relations.

### 2. COMPETITIONS ORGANISERS

2.1 General management of the organisation and holding of the World SAMBO Championship 2015 shall be the responsibility of the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS) together with Latvian SAMBO Clubs Association with the support of the Latvian Ministry of Education and the Education, Culture and Sports Department of the Riga City Council.

### 3. DATES AND VENUE

- 3.1. World SAMBO Championship shall be held from 8 to 12 October 2015.
- 3.2. Competition venue: Riga Olympic Centre at 6b Grostonas St., Riga.
- 3.3. Accreditation will take place in Riga Olympic Centre (conference hall, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, 6b Grostonas St., Riga).

- 3.4. Participants will be accommodated in:  
 Bellevue Park Hotel Riga, 1 Slokas St., Riga  
 Conference Hotel TOMO, 44 Raunas St., Riga

#### 4. PARTICIPATION TERMS

- 4.1. The following athletes shall be qualified for the competition:
- youth (men and women) – 17–18 years (born in 1997–1998);
  - juniors (men and women) – 19-20 years (born in 1995–1996);
  - athletes affiliated to their National SAMBO Federations
  - athletes who have FIAS license book with a corresponding seal confirming payment for the FIAS annual license for 2015. Athletes arriving for participation in the competitions without having timely paid for the FIAS annual license shall pay for the annual license (25 US dollars) on site. Athletes without the license book on hand may purchase it for 10 US dollars from the Treasurer or a person authorised by him.
  - athletes who have a medical insurance.

#### 5. TECHNICAL TERMS

- 5.1. World SAMBO Championship shall be held in accordance with FIAS Sport and Organization Rules and the International SAMBO Competitions Rules. Direct management of the competitions shall be entrusted to the panel of referees approved by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Commission.

- 5.2. Weight categories:

- 5.3. Individual World SAMBO Championship shall be held according to the Olympic system with consolation from semifinalists. Team medal count is conducted according to the Olympic principle (by number of gold, silver and bronze medals).
- 5.4. National teams of countries worldwide are invited for participation in the championship. Official delegation shall include: head – 1 person, coach – 2 persons, referee – 1 person, physician – 2 persons, athletes – 40 persons. 1 athlete from a country may participate in one weight category.
- 5.5. Participation in the competition is allowed only if each athlete has a medical insurance to be submitted to the Mandate Commission of the competitions. Competition participants are insured at the expense of the sending organisation.
- 5.6. All delegations shall submit the phonograms of their national anthems (on electronic media) during accreditation.

#### 6. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

- 6.1. Each delegation member shall pay a fee in the amount of 100 US dollars per day to the Organizing Committee (accommodation, meals, dinner on the arrival day and breakfast). Minimum accommodation duration is two days.
- 6.2. The cost of transfer from Riga airport (station) to the official hotel and back and during competitions from the official hotel to the competition venue and back costs 20 US dollars for each team member and is paid by the national federations.
- 6.3. In case of individual reservation of accommodation for delegation members, the national federation shall pay a lump-sum fee for participation in the World championship in the amount of 150 US dollars for each team member (accommodation, meals, transfer are not included in this fee) to the Organizing Committee.



- 6.4. World championship participants travel to the competition venue at the expense of sending organisations.
- 6.5. Heads of delegations shall settle all financial issues and meet accreditation requirements on the day of arrival. Payment is made on site **in US dollars**. Payment in **Euro** at the rate of the Bank of Latvia at the date of payment is also possible.
- 6.6. The competition organizers shall provide meals and accommodation for: the FIAS President, the FIAS Secretary General, the Chairman of the Referees Commission and 18 referees. FIAS shall provide meals and accommodation for the Chief Referee, Chief Secretary, Assistant Chief Secretary and 6 referees. FIAS shall pay for the work of the Chief Referee, Chief Secretary and Assistant Chief Secretary at the rate of 100 US dollars for each day of competitions, including the days of arrival and departure. FIAS shall pay for the work of 24 referees at the rate of 50 US dollars for each day of competitions.

## **7. APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION**

  - hotel reservation and information on arrival and departure (form 4) by September 8.
- 7.2. Mass media representatives will pass additional accreditation process at the official FIAS site: <http://sambo-fias.org> in the section Press Centre – Press Accreditation not later than August 20.

## **8. AWARDS**

- 8.1. Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals and diplomas.
- 8.2. Prize-winning teams shall be awarded with cups and diplomas.
- 8.3. Red sambo uniform is required at the awarding ceremony.
