The Chairman, having conducted the meeting behind closed doors, in the order of the provisional measures ordered:

- I. To oblige the representative of the Trade register of Canton of Vaud to remove the record made in the journal on July 18, 2013 (Part 3; № 11440), changing the record made by the defendant, the International Sambo Federation (FIAS), so that the record is published and presented to the public for free access as of on July 15, 2013, subject to the provisions of the following paragraph II:
- II. To oblige the representative of the Trade register of Canton of Vaud to delete from the record made by the defendant, the personal signature of Nicholas Lenz as a secretary general;
- III. to release the claimant Vasily Shestakov and co-claimants from submission of the deposit ;
- IV. to fix the costs of the litigation of provisional measures, including the extraordinary provisional measures, as CHF 1,850 (one thousand eight hundred and fifty CHF), which was brought forward in advance by the claimant;
- V. to defer the decision on the amount of costs of the litigation related to provisional measures until the final decision is made;
- VI. to reject or consider unjustified any other or general conclusions;
- VII. to announce that this decision will have legal effect straight after the deadline for submission of the request for motivation of the decision, if no requests were made, or immediately after both parties were notified about the motivated court decision.
